5) Old Business:

- <u>Vector Control</u>. Discussion of listed possible spray sites, mostly centered around ballfields and parks.
 Additional sites advised to consider (4H grounds, Merom Conference Center, Fairbanks Community
 Center, Sullivan County Community Hospital grounds). Board notified spraying will begin at Park/Lake
 and will then begin at other locations as able later in the month.
- <u>Budget</u> discussion: The preliminary budget was passed out last meeting. Updated version reviewed.
 Discussion regarding additional of emergency preparedness staff addition. Motion to approve 2019
 budget by Ms. Pounds, Second by Ms. Dugan, all favor. This budget will be forwarded to the County
 Council.

6) New Business:

- <u>Tire Take Back</u>: A discussion was initiated regarding a tire take back program. The City of Sullivan is considering this. Greene County has a program. Possible grant funding was discussed. It was decided additional information needed to be gained regarding where to send tires, cost, recycling, etc. The Solid Waste Board and the Recycling Center will be contacted regarding options/details. The general consensus was this would be a good program in order to decrease mosquito habitat and improve recycling. This would be a good use of Trust Account Grant Funding next year after additional details are discovered. No formal action was taken.
- <u>Pool Inspections</u> were discussed. Dr. Gamble completed the Certified Pool Operator Course and the Certified Pool & Spa Course. He will be inspecting the local pools with the assistance of ISDH staff next week.
- 7) Good of the Order: Ms. Pounds inquired regarding the process for onsite septic evaluations and the timelines of these inspections. The rule and process was reviewed. Any potential issues will be discussed with staff.
